Introduction

Logline

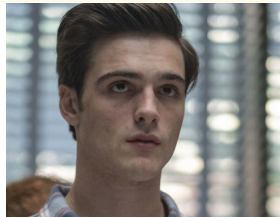
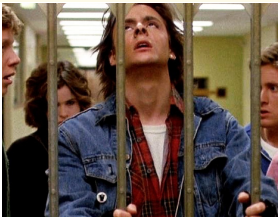
Characters



Cindy is a somewhat repressed and recently separated high-school teacher with a potential breast cancer diagnosis, who's found the urge to live again, against all odds. She transforms herself into the powerful woman she feels she used to be, but takes things too far in the process.



Roger is Cindy's ex, who's going through an intense mid-life crisis and is planning to pull off a diamond heist. His mid-life crisis includes a late 90's Camaro and the young big-breasted blonde from the gym.



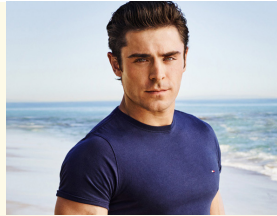
Cristian is a high-school senior with anger-management issues who, rumor has it, is on probation for assaulting a police officer.



Deon is a star running-back and star student who's family can't afford to send to college. He hopes his senior year football career will lead to a college scholarship.



Sam is a straight-A high school student and a journalist for the school paper. Her boredom causes her to constantly start arguments with everyone about whatever causes are prevalent at the moment.



Kip is a football coach and lady's man that is trying to have sex with Cindy. He keeps up, physically, with his student athletes and has all the teachers drooling for him.

Act 1

Cindy, a teacher at a fledgling high school, gets news of a possible cancer diagnosis, a cheating husband, and an overdrawn bank account. She's eager to re-invent herself when she finds her now ex-husband's detailed plans to rob a jewelry store.



Act 2



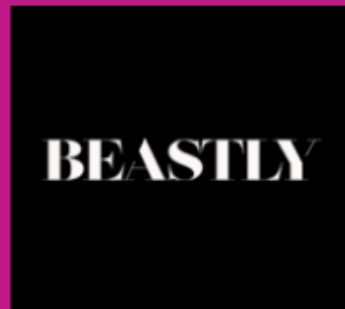
A note on the Student-Teacher Love Affair

Depending on the age, a student-teacher love affair could result in statutory rape charges, but that is not the case in this film. Cristian is a senior in high school and his 18th birthday is part of the story. The relationship with Cindy becomes sexual as a result of that birthday.

Furthermore, the audience will themselves sexualize our student characters due to their adult-like appearance; and will root for Cindy to indulge, given her dire situation.

The female empowerment development is integral to this story. Our girl gets what she wants. This world owes it to her.
